

Álvaro Teixeira Lopes is a Professor in the Department of Communication and Art at the University of Aveiro, as well as the Artistic Director of the Santa Cecilia International Competition (CISC) and the Director of the Silva Monteiro Music Course (CMSM). Álvaro Teixeira Lopes studied at the Porto Music Conservatory and continued his studies in Vienna and Paris with Paul Badura-Skoda, Noel Flores, and Marian Ribicky. Awarded several prizes, he has developed an intense national and international career as a soloist and chamber musician and has been invited to perform at some of the most prestigious festivals worldwide.

As the artistic director of several festivals, he has conducted numerous masterclasses in Portugal, France, Brazil, Taiwan, China, Spain, and Italy. Frequently invited to be part of piano competition juries, he has served as a jury member for the Orbetello, Rospigliosi, Rina Sala Gallo, Iturbi, Compositores de España, Isidor Basić, Pro-Piano competitions, the Concours International de Piano de Lyon, Concours International d'Épinal, César Franck International Competition, Cleveland Virtuoso, Maestro Arts Taiwan, Porto Piano International Competition, Rio de Janeiro International Piano Festival, and many others around the world.
